Lifetime Achievement Award



This award goes to an individual who has made long-lasting environmental contributions that improve environmental health in their community over the course of many years. Mention Jonathan Samuelson's name along the banks of the Kuskokwim, and people will most likely smile, and say in an awed voice "Isn't he incredible?". Jonathan knows that the fish bring families and communities together and is focused on protecting the Kuskokwim Watershed for the next seven generation. To this end, he serves on the Native Village of Georgetown's Council, is a Vice-President of The Kuskokwim Corporation, Vice-Chair of the Kuskokwim River Inter-Tribal Fish Commission, and ad-

visor for the Tamamta program. Jonathan shines as an inspirational leader with an uncanny ability to support, empower and highlight the inner skills of the people around him.

Jonathan believes that a healthy environment is a pre-requisite for healthy communities. The impact of Jonathan's extends beyond the Kuskokwim and the present. He focuses many of his efforts on shaping the future generations of tribal environmental leaders. As an advisor for the Tamamta program, he is helping transform graduate education and research and bridge gaps between Indigenous and Western sciences.

Georgetown Tribal Council March 26, 2023 Quarterly Meeting

The Georgetown Tribal Council, the governing body of the Native Village of Georgetown, met on Saturday, March 26th, 2023 for their quarterly meeting. Council Members that attended the in-person meeting were Traci Maczynski, Gary Fredericks, Valerie Dudley, and Buddy Kutch (by phone). Others in attendance Helen Vanderpool (by phone).

During the meeting the Council:

- Approved the agenda with added agenda items
- Approved the meeting minutes for December 10, 2022 and the September 17, 2022 (tabled at the Dec 10 meeting)
- Reviewed Administrative reports from the Tribal Administrator and staff members.
- Heard committee reports from the Environmental Committee, Land Committee, Enrollment Committee, Policy Committee, Pre-Audit Committee, and Community Center Committee.
- Approved the three pending enrollment applications that were reviewed by the Enrollment Committee
- Set the date and location for the 2023 Georgetown Annual meeting
- Reviewed and discussed the updated code of conduct policy. Sent it back to the Policy Committee for more work
- Discussed how to use the clean up green up money from Donlin and asked Administration to purchase reusable shopping bags with the NVG logo to send to each household.
- Discussed the Regional Tribal Government after reviewing the report the Tribal Administrator presented from his meeting with their representatives.
- Made a decision to enter into an employment contract with Jerry Fredericks to complete the community center
- Made a decision to hire at least one carpenter and four labors for the completion of the community center
- Made a decision to have Administration purchase a Bobcat with accessories to be shipped to Georgetown for use in completing the community center
- Set the next meeting date for June 24th at 11 AM
